

SICILY: FOR SICILY IS THE KEY TO EVERYTHING... TUESDAY II TO TUESDAY 18 NOVEMBER 2014 NICHOLAS FRIEND and LUCY WALKER

To have seen Italy without having seen Sicily is to not have seen Italy at all, for Sicily is the clue to everything. 13 April 1787, Johann Wolfgang Von Goethe

In 1786, Goethe abruptly abandoned his personal and literary life in Carlsbad to set out to Italy on a two-year quest for a deepened understanding of the origins of western civilisation. After travelling through Verona, Venice, Bologna, Rome and Naples, he embarked on a ship to Sicily where, for the first time, he encountered genuine Greek (as opposed to Roman) architecture. Seeing the Temple of Concord at Agrigento, one of the best-preserved Doric temples in the Western world, he was startled by its unadorned simplicity.

The largest group of Greek temples in the whole of Magna Graecia, sits 'cheek by jowl' with hauntingly beautiful 17c towns, their buildings tied together by sweeping theatrical facades like stage curtains, which though the opposite of classical, are just as impressive as the monumental Greek temples. Altogether, this geographic triangle in south-eastern Sicily, between Catania, Siracusa and Agrigento, reveals a history of Sicilian building and culture, from tombs to temples, cave-dwellings to churches, and Norman palaces to Renaissance piazze. This INSCAPE tour stimulates the mind, but does not exhaust the patience or the body, as we explore in depth the imaginative and physical attributes of an astounding presence of sacred and civil buildings within a proscribed area.

While enjoying the delicious Sicilian cuisine, whose every dish contains references to the island's extraordinary culinary heritage and the island's abundance, we contemplate Sicily's rich literary heritage: from Greek playwrights, Roman and Hebrew orators, Arab poets, to more recent novelists, playwrights and storytellers: Giovanni Verga, Leonardo Sciascia, Tomasi di Lampedusa, author of *The Leopard*. If one could choose just one place to visit where one could witness everything from the culture of Hellenic antiquity to the glories of the Middle Ages, on to the wonders of the Renaissance, and the challenges of modern existence, Sicily would be that one verdant place. Sicily does indeed provide the clue to 'everything.'
