HIGHLIGHTS

Outstanding productions of three comic plays: The Taming of the Shrew, As You Like It, and The Provoked Wife, by Sir John Vanbrugh, playwright, architect and spy; private visit to moated 14c manor house, Baddesley Clinton, home of the eccentric Marmion Ferrers and the captivating Rebecca 'Dulcibella' Orpen, with three secret priest's holes; a private visit to Arbury Hall, 'Strawberry Hill Gothic' Warwickshire home of 18c poet Sir Roger Newdigate for an anniversary champagne toast to George Eliot born on the estate 200 years ago with readings from her 'Scenes from a Clerical Life'.
